About Mass Timber

Mass timber is an engineered wood product that serves as an environmentally-friendly replacement for structural concrete and steel in mid-rise and high-rise buildings. Some of the environmental benefits of using wood is that it's a renewable resource, it's approximately 50% carbon by volume and mass timber products have significantly less embodied energy than competing products. This makes the use of mass timber a good strategy for carbon sequestration in the built environment. There are several types of mass timber products and Sylvecta will primarily manufacture a variant known as cross-laminated timber (CLT).
